Send us a 20-second video proudly saying the following:

- Your first name
- Your current career/passion/identifier
- The Girl Scout award you earned (Gold Award, First Class, Curved Bar, etc.)
- The phrase "I'm 100 Years Gold."

Examples:

"My name is Carla. I'm a law professor. I am a proud Gold Award Girl Scout, and I am 100 years Gold."

"My name is Joan. I'm a mom and a teacher. I earned First Class as a Girl Scout in 1972, and I am proud to be 100 years Gold."

"My name is Lara, and I'm an English major at USC. I earned my Girl Scout Gold Award, and I am 100 years Gold."

"I'm Susan. I'm an engineer at JPL. I am a proud Girl Scout alumna and earned the Curved Bar. I am 100 Years Gold."

Your video *must*:

- *Not* be more than 1 GB in size
- *Not* be more than 20 seconds in length
- Be shot horizontally (no vertically shot videos)—especially important if using an iPhone to film.
- Be recorded in a quiet setting (no background noise), with speaker talking loudly and enunciating her words.
- Be a .wmv, .mp3, .avi, or .mov file
- Have a file name of your name (eg. JaneDoe.wmv)
- Be sent to pr@girlscoutsla.org. If the file is too large to email, please send using <https://www.wetransfer.com/>.
