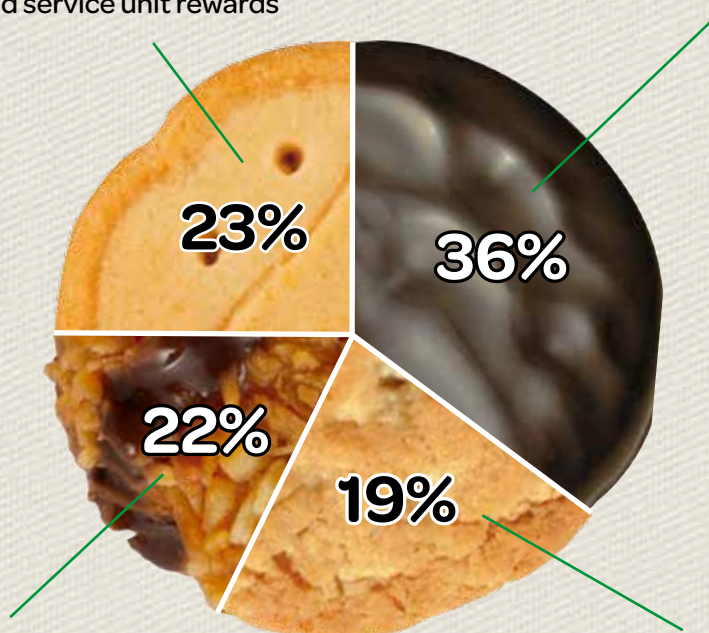
How does \$5/box support Girl Scouts?

Troop Earnings & Rewards: \$1.13-1.23

- ▶ 95¢ for troop earnings (\$1.05 for many older girls), which girls use for:
 - Field trips and travel
 - Summer camp
 - Programs and events
 - Community service projects
 - Program supplies and uniforms
 - Journey books and *Girl's Guide to Girl Scouting*
 - Girl Scout membership
- ▶ 18¢ for girl, troop, and service unit rewards

High Quality Girl Scout Programs: \$1.81

- ▶ Program areas include:
 - Leadership
 - Business & Financial Literacy (includes the cookie program)
 - Outdoor Adventure (includes camp)
 - STEAM (science, technology, engineering, art, math)
 - Healthy Living
- ▶ Maintaining Girl Scout camp and program sites
- ▶ Council-hosted girl and volunteer events



Girl and Volunteer Support: \$1.10

- ▶ Financial assistance and outreach to underserved girls
- ▶ Bringing the Girl Scout experience to more neighborhoods
- ▶ Volunteer training, materials, and recognitions
- ▶ Volunteer recruitment
- ▶ Volunteer support and resources

Product Costs: \$.96

- ▶ Cost of cookies from the baker
- ▶ Transportation and storage of cookies
- ▶ Sales materials (includes eBudde)
