Is my Scout guaranteed a spot at College Day 2017?

There will be 150 spaces available for scouts this year. Please be aware that there are limited spaces for scouts when signing up. If we exceed 150 scouts, we will update this application and the Bruin Scout website (www.bruinscout.wordpress.com) to reflect the waitlist status. We would like to give all scouts a fair chance to participate in College Day, so top priority will be given to scouts who have not attended College Day in the past.

How will I know if my Scout has received a spot?

When we have reached the limit of spaces available, all applicants will receive an email with an attached roster of the 150 scouts that have been accepted. After that, all submitted applications will be placed on the waitlist. Spots that open up will be given to those on the waitlist in order of submission.

Is there a cost to attending College Day?

The event will be free to all attendants. Because of this, we ask those who cannot attend to notify us as soon as possible so that other Scouts can attend the event in their place.

Can parents attend College Day?

Yes, we encourage parents to join in on College Day! During the first half of the day, parents will be able to attend a Parent Panel where their questions about the college and scouting experiences will be answered by Bruin Scouts alumni. For the second half of the day, parents can enjoy a tour of the beautiful UCLA campus.
