Location: Six Flags Hurricane Harbor Valencia, CA (Private event for GSGLA, closed to the public)

**Who may attend?** Girls who sell 500+ boxes of cookies, plus their 1 adult chaperone (required). *This is a private event for Girl Scouts of Greater Los Angeles only.* <u>No additional tickets are available for this event.</u>

Where will we park, and is there a cost? Attendees can park on site in the Six Flags lot, parking passes will be issued at no cost to our guests of the private event.

Will there be food served similar to past Club 500 events? Yes! Food stations will be located throughout the park, and Paradise Picnic Pavilion offering a variety of fun and healthy food choices, including vegetarian options. All menu items are prepared on-site by the park's chef and include BBQ beef brisket, grilled chicken sandwich, baked beans, mac'n'cheese, corn cobbett, garden salad, and watermelon .... Oh and let's not forget the hot dogs and potato chips. In addition, there will be supplemental water/drink stations throughout the park so everyone stays hydrated. Will discount tickets to the resort be available for additional family members? Absolutely, the Disneyland resort has arranged a special website just for the use of friends and family of the girls who are attending Elite 1000 this year.

Where will we park, and is there a cost? Attendees will use the Disney resort parking lot of their choosing. Attendees will be responsible for parking; fees may vary depending on the location.

What program with the girls participate in this year? Girls will participate in the very popular Y.E.S. (Youth Education Series) program this year. Girls will be assigned to their Y.E.S. program based on their Girl Scout program level. All Y.E.S. programs will take place inside of California Adventure Park
