C. PHOTO SCAVENGER HUNT (Take Action)

Complete three of the 11 activities below. When completed, send your three digital photos to photos@girlscoutsla.org and type "Earth To Echo" in the subject line. Include your name and Troop #. You could be featured on the council website or social media channels!*

- Environmental protection is an important cause! What are you doing to save your universe? What cool places would you take an alien like Echo to show him the beauty of the earth? Take a picture of it and save your photo.
- Acting can be pretty fun. Young actors, like those in the movie *Earth To Echo*, have to convince an audience that the character they are playing is sad, excited, or even scared. Can you do that? Make up a skit, song, or cheer relating to friendship or outer space. Take a picture of you with an excited emotion. Save your photo.



- Remembering an experience means you will have a great story to tell later. Use a small box to put together a troop or family time capsule. Fill it with pictures, a letter, or trendy things you have and mark it “To be opened in ____ years” (you fill in the blank). Take a picture with you time capsule. Save your photo.
- Teach a friend, sibling, troop, or anyone something about the universe. You can teach them about the solar system, stars, moon, etc. Take a picture of you in action. Save your photo.
- Heroes are all around you. You can be a hero too, just by being a girl of courage, confidence, and character. Draw yourself as a hero and take a picture of you with your drawing. Save your photo.
- Technology is so cool! What is your favorite tech device? Your phone, your tablet, your computer, your e-reader? How does technology help you every day? Take a picture with your favorite tech device. Save your photo.
- Outdoor adventures are an important part of Girl Scouting. Get outside and play a game with friends. Take a picture of the fun. Save your photo.
- Explore the universe by learning about constellations. Draw a picture of a constellation you like or one that starts with the first letter of your first or last name. Be sure to write the name of the constellation on your drawing. Take a picture of you with your drawing. Save your photo.
- Create a spaceship out of things you find around the house (e.g., paper towel rolls, boxes, paper clips, pens, cans, etc). Take a picture of you with your spaceship. Save your photo.
- Help out! Echo asked a group of kids for help and they stepped up for the cause. A cause campaign is a way people help the community. Think of something you did or want to do to help the community. Give your “cause campaign” a title or name. For example: if you wanted to help abandoned animals by delivering treats to them, you might name your cause “Presents for Pets.” Write your cause title on a sheet of paper and take a photo with it. Save your photo.
- Opportunity is knocking! Are you ready for an adventure? You have the opportunity to join other Girl Scouts at the exclusive screening for *Earth To Echo* and cheer on the characters as they go on an adventure of a lifetime. Take a picture of you with an *Earth To Echo* movie poster (at a theater, in your neighborhood, or council service center, etc.). Save your photo.
