

Property Name: El Potrero



El Potrero is an outdoor camp comprising 390 acres of meadows and oak trees located adjacent to the Cleveland National Forest. The camp is a designated wildlife sanctuary. The camp is a primitive camp, which means the structures lack modern conveniences such as electricity. There are 11 camping sites that support tent camping, restroom platforms that have flush toilets and showers, along with a ranger's house.

The site is available during the spring for outdoor training sessions and large primitive camping events, with up to 600 participants in attendance. There is no permanent onsite ranger at El Potrero, so staff must be deployed when the camp is in use.
