Johnstone Program Center, circa 1955, is situated on a hillside. Adjacent West Arrow Highway is what is commonly referred to as Upper Johnstone, which is a brick and stone building with a large rectangular main room, fireplace, current kitchen, modern multi-stall ADA compliant restroom, and one single stall restroom. To the rear of the main room exists a shallow concrete patio.

Down the hillside exists what is commonly known as Lower Johnstone, a semi-wooded area with trees on flat and sloping grounds. There are two restrooms that require improvements, a fire circle, and a creek that functions as a swale line for storm water runoff from the adjacent hillside homes.

The property is primarily used for Troop meetings, small outdoor trainings, and occasional overnight camping.
