You got questions. I've got answers!



Q. How can I buy a Mall Madness T-shirt?

A. A shirt will be included for each girl and adult. Use the form included in this packet. No shirts will be sold at the event.

Q What will the girls be doing?

A There are a variety of activities set up all over the mall. Troops are invited to apply to host an activity booth. Check the packet for more info on hosting a booth. Some stores will be open for a few hours during the night.

Q Will there be a patch?

A Yes. Patches are included for both girls and adults. Adults will receive the patches upon check out.

Q Is food included?

A Yes, food and snacks are included for both the adults and the girls. The caterer for 2014 has not been finalized. Certain food court vendors will be open to purchase other food and snacks.

Q How do I make changes to my registrations?

A To make changes to an existing registration please email <u>vgomez@girlscoutsla.org</u>. Keep in mind, that a girl space can be changed with other girls NOT adults. Add-ons are only allowed if space is available. ALL CHANGES AND CANCELLATIONS MUST BE COMPLETED BY CLOSE OF REGISTRATION.

Q My daughter has a friend that wants to go but she isn't a Girl Scout, can she go?

A Yes, please register her through eBiz as a non Girl Scout and included her in your troop roster.

Q I want to volunteer that night, but my troop isn't going, can I do that?

A Yes, please contact Monica for more information. MPaniagua@girlscoutsla.org

Q How many adults can go per group and what will the adults be doing?

A Adults do count towards capacity and we'd like to have as many girls as possible attend the event. Safety-wise ratio is to be followed. All adults going are asked to work a shift of 2 hours during the event. You will be signing up for station online at iVolunteer. Adults attending will receive an email with the link closer to the event date.

Q What time do doors open and close?

A Attendees can line up before 10:00 pm; however, the doors will open at 10:00 pm. Troops may leave the mall as early as 5am, all troops must be out of the mall by 6:00 am.

Q Do I have to attend a meeting? How do I get my wristbands?

A There is not a meeting to attend. All information will be relayed through email and postal mail. Wrist-bands will be mailed to the main contact of the troop. We would like to not have wristbands distributed the night of the event.

Q Are men allowed to attend?

A Yes...only if they are up for the challenge. There is a separate sleeping area and a designated restroom for Men. Just like all other adults, you must be background checked and a registered member to attend.

SERVICE PROJECT—"Care Packages"

Every troop is asked to participate in the service project. We will be collecting items to help MEND Poverty create "Care Package" for homeless families in the San Fernando Valley.

So, what goes in a Care Package?

Here are the principal items MEND places in the package:

FOOD

The MEND Foodbank needs your help with the following items:

- Any low-sodium, low sugar, sugar substitute items for those clients with special dietary needs
- Cereal (whole grain, low sugar)
- Canned soups, stews & chilies
- Canned vegetables
- Canned tomatoes
- Canned tuna, chicken and spam
- Low-sodium canned meats and vegetables
- Pasta and rice
- Dried beans of ALL KINDS, quinoa, lentils

*Tip: Less expensive store brand items feed a family in need as effectively as bran name items: check your local market mailers!

SHOWER PROGRAM

The MEND homeless Shower program needs your help with the following items:

- Ziploc bags of ALL SIZES
- Travel size toothpaste
- Travel bottles (for shampoos)
- Shower Loofahs
- Wash cloths
- Disposable razors

You can also attach a note inside, no last names please. Keep in mind, that some families have no possessions when they enter a facility. Make it special!

There will be a designated area to drop off the items before enter the event.

Adult volunteer information:

- Troop must meet standards of adult chaperones for this event as found in *Volunteer Essentials*.
- All adults attending this event will be expected to work sometime during the event. This event is safe and successful because of everyone's support.
- All adults must be a registered Girl Scout and have cleared a background check and have a volunteer application on file.
- At least one adult from each troop must be <u>Indoor Overnight trained</u>. Check out the training schedule on the GSGLA website.
- Male volunteers are allowed, however, they will have a designated sleeping and restroom area.
- Troops will need to fill out the parent permission form and submit to their SUM for approval. This is an overnight event.
- Certain crafts will be identified for adults to do them as well. If it is a "girl craft only", please do not do the craft. Supplies are purchased based on the registration numbers.

Where to park and enter:

Please see the parking diagram on the next page for parking location. We will be lining up and entering through the mall entrance between 9021Pho and Salon Dior. Please make sure you are lined up and ready to enter the mall as a Troop.

What to bring: THE MORE YOU BRING, THE MORE YOU HAVE TO CARRY AND HOLD WHILE IN LINE.

Girls: Blankets, sleeping bags, pillows, refillable water bottle, slippers (slippers can only be worn at the sleeping area. Closed toed shoes must be worn while walking around the mall. Stores will be open for shopping, a list of stores open will be sent closer to the event. Girls can bring spending money, I do encourage a mall gift card. Girls are responsible for their own belongings and money. Cameras. Cell phones are allowed, but troop leader has the final say on whether you can bring them. PLEASE PUT GIRLS' NAMES IN WALLETS.

Adults: a foldable chair, reusable coffee cup, reusable water bottle and a good attitude.

Troop: please bring a troop sign, no bigger than a poster size paper. Use Masking Tape or Painters Tape. This will mark your sleeping area. NO GLITTER ALLOWED IN THE MALL OR ON THE SIGNS

What to wear:

Pajamas are ok, shirts that cover shoulders and the midsection, fun hair, crazy hats, anything that inspires you. No open toe shoes. Just be comfortable. Girl Scout dress code is still enforced. We love to see the adults dress up as well.


Where am I sleeping?

Sleep? There's none of that going on! You will lay out your sleeping area along the storefronts of closed stores. Please be mindful to not spread out excessively wide. Only go out as long as a sleeping bag length. Please do not set up chairs/blankets in the aisles upstairs, your items will be moved out of the way. Post your troop signs above your area.

Do I need to stay with the troop all night?

Not unless you want to. The doors are locked and monitored by adults. I would suggest having check in times with your troop. Go over with your troop that this is still a Girl Scout event and to please act, speak, and treat others accordingly.






