Outdoor Education Level 1 Self Study

Thank you for your time in taking this Outdoor Education Level 1 Self Study course. Outdoor experiences for girls are very important to enhance their growing awareness of their world.

Outdoor education training is required if a troop will be camping outdoors. One adult in each troop/group that will be present at the outdoor activities is required to take these courses. Several levels of training are offered, depending on the type of camping activities the troop will be participating in.

Level 1 Outdoor Education is required of an adult to take a troop on the following type of events: indoor overnight experiences where girls sleep in cabins, established campgrounds with platform tents, or indoor slumber parties where food is provided or the girls cook in a conventional kitchen. No fires involved. No outdoor cooking. No pitching tents.

Please read the materials and take the test; then return the test either by email, fax, or walk in to the Volunteer Development Manager at the <u>nearest service center</u>. You will be notified once your test has been assessed.
