- Carries out assigned waterfront activities and teaches water skills as assigned by Waterfront Director
- Assists in the development and monitoring of waterfront safety measures according to Girl Scout and ACA Standards including training of staff and campers
- Participates in waterfront fitness program including regularly scheduled emergency drills
- Maintains effective relationships with other staff and works as a member of a staff team
- Assists in the care of waterfront equipment, facilities and supplies
- Evaluates and reports as requested

- Documented experience delivering program to children.
- Experience and demonstrated sensitivity in working with people from various ethnic, religious, and socioeconomic backgrounds
