Camp Lakota is situated in the beautiful Los Padres National Forest. Camp Lakota is available for year-round enjoyment and includes winterized indoor facilities, road conditions permitting. Camp Lakota covers nearly 60 acres of pristine pine forests, rolling hills, and open fields and offers a refreshing back-to-nature experience.

Camp Osito-Rancho is a four-season, 160-acre outdoor recreation facility that offers lots of mountain-top hiking and wetlands to explore. The property is nestled among tall pines at 7,500 feet elevation in Big Bear Lake in the San Bernardino Mountains.

El Potrero is a unique camp comprising 390 acres of meadows and California live oaks, located in the Cleveland National Forest. The property, designated a Wildlife Sanctuary, has eleven sites developed specifically for troop tent camping.

Skyland Ranch, located in the San Jacinto Mountains, features two lodges and an open air camping unit. This beautiful property encompasses 195 acres of pine and oak forests, chaparral and apple orchards. * Limited cooking availability at Skyland Ranch. Indoor kitchen cooking available only in Duncan Lodge.
