- B. You will receive an automated reply that asks you to "confirm your donation". Reply "YES" to this message to confirm your donation.
- C. A \$5.00 charge will appear on your mobile phone bill per donation*

2. Dedications via Mobile Devices

(for donations above \$5.00 or multiple \$5.00 donations)

A. Send the following text message to 91011:

FLOAT

B. You will receive a messsage saying a representative will call you to confirm your donation, names you'd like for each dedication and payment information

3. Dedications via the Internet

- B. Follow the instructions and fill out required fields
- C. A confirmation will be emailed to you to confirm your submission
